- Creating and managing multiple data providers in a single document.
- Editing the generated SQL for advanced query customization.

Unit Three: Designing and Formatting Professional Reports

- Working with various report blocks like tables, crosstabs, and forms.
- Creating and customizing different chart types for data visualization.
- Applying breaks, sections, and outlines to structure report data.
- Implementing sorts, report filters, and ranking for focused analysis.
- Using conditional formatting rules to highlight key information.
- Applying corporate branding with headers, footers, and watermarks.
- Mastering report element formatting and alignment options.
